

**Freezing Level:** This field shows the level in the atmosphere above which the temperature drops below the freezing point (0°C; 32°F). The variation in freezing level over time and space as meteorological conditions change is an important piece of information for pilots and aviation weather forecasters attempting to plan flights which will encounter a minimum of icing conditions. We currently depict the lowest possible freezing level in this graphic and do not attempt to adjust for “warm noses” associated with multiple freezing levels, though this is accounted for in the other icing products.
